CERTIFIED RESULTS FOR THE MARCH 3, 2009 PRIMARY NOMINATING AND CONSOLIDATED ELECTIONS

Los Angeles Interim City Clerk Karen E. Kalfayan announced today that the certified results for the March 3, 2009, City of Los Angeles Primary Nominating and Consolidated Elections (see attached) have been released and can be viewed on the Office of the City Clerk - Election Division website at: <http://cityclerk.lacity.org/election/>.

The certified results will be submitted to the Los Angeles City Council which shall declare the results of the election and the run-off candidates for the General Municipal Election (see note below).

The final bulletin includes election results for the City of Los Angeles, the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD), the Los Angeles Community College District (LACCD), and a final bulletin with combined totals from the other cities that conducted consolidated elections with the City of Los Angeles.

Candidates were elected to the offices of Mayor, Controller and City Council in Districts 1, 3, 7, 9, 11, 13 and 15; LAUSD Offices 2, 4, and 6; and LACCD Seats 4 and 7. A run-off election for the offices of City Attorney, City Council District 5 and LACCD Seats 2 and 6 will take place on May 19, 2009.

Please note the May 19, 2009, City of Los Angeles General Municipal Election has been consolidated with the State Special Election and will be conducted by the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk.
